Entry Fee: \$60 per dog per run. Fee includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee for each entry. Entries received without correct fees will not be processed until corrected. Samoyed Club of America (SCA) will not refund any overpayment.

Entry Process: Enter online at <u>www.sca2019.com/herding.html</u>. Fill out the entry form online, then save to your computer. Follow the link on the website page to pay for your entries. Finally, email the entry form to the address listed on the website page, <u>colliesherd@gmail.com</u>.

Entries Open on May 4, 2019, at 9:00 a.m. CDT

Entries close at 6:00 p.m. CDT, on Saturday, Sept.7, 2019, at the Secretary's address, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. All entries received after numerical limits are reached will be placed on the alternates' list in the order received. Drawing for run order will be held at 8:00 p.m. on Saturday, Sept. 7, 2019, at the Secretary's residence. Multiple entries by a single handler will be adjusted, if possible, to provide time between runs.

Open to all herding breeds on Aug. 25, 2019. Prior to Aug. 25, open to Samoyed dogs only.

Test Hours: 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Monday, Sept. 23, 2019, or at the conclusion of tests. Judge's briefing for first test will be at 8:30 am. The second test will follow the first.

Directions to show site

From that Intersection: Go 2 miles South (right) on Hwy. 275 (Wabash Ave.), turn left (East) on Pioneer Trail, go 4 miles East, then turn right (South) on 240th Street. Go 1.2 miles South, cross bike trail, then it's the next place on the right (West). Look for the Basset Hound mailbox.

Notices to Exhibitors

- The show site will be available to exhibitors at 7:30 a.m. Monday, Sept. 23, 2019. Dogs must be removed from the trial site immediately following the conclusion of the tests.
- These tests will be held outdoors. Please bring shade tents, chairs, crates, water for you & your dogs, and clean up items. A cool-off tub for dogs will be provided.
- The safety of the dogs is the primary concern. By entering this event, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all requirements safely.
- Dogs may not be left in closed vehicles without proper ventilation. If dogs are found in distress, SCA will take appropriate action.
- All dogs present must be held on leash or otherwise restricted except when working. Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena during another dog's performance. (See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the AKC herding regulations.)
- Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent (unless the dog is replaced by an alternate from the alternates list); disqualified; excused; or barred from competition by action of the Judge or Trial Committee.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the trials cannot open or be completed because of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. SCA reserves the right to cancel these events in the event of extreme weather conditions and no entry fee refunds will be made in such case.
- Owners are responsible for errors on completed entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing, by telegram or e-mail prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.
- Telephone, e-mail, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an Official AKC Entry Form and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules of the Official AKC Form are not acceptable.
- Post-dated and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A collection fee of \$35.00 will be added to the amount of each returned check.
- No refund for duplicate entries. Care will be taken to find duplicates, however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.
- No entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed on the trial site.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds of entry fees if a person is asked to leave the trial site.
- Absolutely no dogs under 6 months of age are permitted on the trial grounds.
- Exhibitors alone are responsible for being at the trial arena gate when it is their turn to run. Judges are not required to wait for any dog.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Management is not responsible for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at the show is in the care and custody and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- SCA, Sunshine Farm, the trial secretary, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors, handlers, their employees, or children, etc., or to any of their dogs or property. Entrants and spectators to this show do so entirely at their own risk.
- SCA does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for these events.
- This show is governed by the American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read the AKC agreement on the entry form.
