• ENTRY INFORMATION: LIMITS, FEES, DATES, and TIMES

- 1. These trials are Pre-Entry ONLY.
- 2. Rally is limited to 55 runs for each trial; Obedience is limited to 35 runs. The judge is limited to a total of 8 hours of judging time each day.

3. Pre-entry Fees

- \$20 per dog per event type; \$15 second class for the same dog per same event type. If a dog is entered in both obedience and rally that is considered a first entry for both event types.
- 4. **Pre-entry Closing Date:** Pre-entries will be accepted until Tuesday, June 4, 2019, at 6:00 p.m. CDT NO Pre-entries will be accepted or processed after that time. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 5. NO Day-of-Show Entries.
- 6. Each dog must be entered on a separate official UKC Performance entry form. (see attachment)
- 7. No telephone, e-mail, or fax entries will be accepted.
- 8. Any entry missing crucial information will not be processed, nor counted as received, until authorization is obtained.
- 9. **Substitution Policy:** There will be no substitutions. An unentered dog may not be substituted for an entered dog.
- 10. Checks will be held until closing.
- 11. Event hours are Friday, June 7th Sunday June 9th, 2019: 7:30 a.m. 2:00 p.m.
 - Rally—Start of judging all three days will be 8:00 a.m.
 - Obedience Start of judging all three days will follow the completion of the Rally Classes.

SUBMITTING ENTRIES

- Entries must be submitted on the Official UKC Performance Entry form included with this Premium List.
 You can type your information into this form. You can type in the information at this website:
 (https://www.ukcdogs.com/docs/showforms/performance-entry.pdf) before printing. Photocopies of this form may also be used.
- 2. **Mailed Entries** must include all fees. Any mailed entries received without all fees will not be processed until such fees have been paid.

PAYMENT FOR ENTRIES

- 1. Pre-entry payment must be made by check or money order. No entry will be processed without full payment.
- 2. Make checks payable to *Friends of BDOC*. Checks must be payable in U.S. funds.
- 3. Post-dated checks or returned checks do not constitute valid entry fees. Friends of BDOC will add a collection fee of \$35.00 to the amount of each returned check or money order.

ENTRY CANCELLATION & REFUNDS

- Entry cancellations MUST be received in writing (includes e-mail) prior to the closing of Pre-entries and MUST include the dog's breed, UKC number, and name. Cancellations received by telephone are NOT acceptable.
- 2. No refunds will be given for invalid entries and dogs entered in the incorrect class after the event is over.
- 3. No refund of entry fees will be made for entries cancelled after the Pre-entry deadline.
- 4. No entries will be refunded after the event is closed.

- 5. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
- 6. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries before processing. If a duplicate entry is processed, however, no refund will be made.
- 7. Entry overpayments will not be refunded.
- 8. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the host organization it is impossible to open or to complete a show or trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- 9. If, in the opinion of the host club, the well-being of dogs, exhibitors, or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snowstorms, tornadoes, lightning, or extreme heat, the host club may cancel or stop a show or trial before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.

ENTRY CONFIRMATION, ARMBANDS, AND JUDGING PROGRAM

- 1. **E-mailed confirmation of entries** will be sent to the e-mail address included on the entry form (please type or print clearly) as soon as possible after the entry has been accepted and processed. Please verify the classes/events your dog is entered into when receiving this e-mail of processed entry. Should there be any errors please contact the Trial Secretary, Norine Nieman, at papenose@cox.net immediately.
- 2. One armband number will be assigned to each dog for all trials in which the dog is entered. Armbands will be available at the check-in table on each day of the day of the trial.
- 3. You will receive updated trial information and a judging schedule after the event closes.

CLASS CHANGE/CORRECTION OF ENTRY

- 1. Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information and any errors on the entry forms. There will be no refunds for invalid entries. Dogs that, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a title after the closing of entries, may be **moved-up** from the entered class to another class for which the dog is now eligible, provided that a request for move-up is made in writing to the Trial Secretary of Friends of BDOC not later than one-half hour <u>prior</u> to the start of the first trial. You must use the official form.
- 2. Dogs may also be **moved-up** between trials.

• GENERAL BUILDING, CRATING, PARKING, & FOOD INFORMATION

- 1. All event location times are Central Daylight Time.
- 2. There will be absolutely NO SMOKING in the Sunshine Obedience School.
- 3. Parking is on the concrete or in the designated area on the SOUTH side of the driveway.
- 4. Crating space is limited. Please stack crates when possible and conserve space.
- 5. On Friday Sunday food will be available for purchase for a nominal fee from 11:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

EXHIBITOR AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. All events are held under the Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc. By entering these shows/trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the event(s) in which they have entered. - 2. Friends of BDOC, its agents; UKC, its agents and its employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators or by exhibitors and handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians. UKC and Friends of BDOC are not responsible for any loss, accidents, or theft.
- 3. The owner or designated handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. The host organization, event committee, and Show Secretary have no obligation or

responsibility for providing service through a public address system, or stewards or runners for the purpose of locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

- 4. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- 5. Please remember to turn off cell phones and/or pagers before entering rings.
- 6. No unentered dogs allowed on the event grounds. Note: no dogs less than 8 weeks of age may be present on the grounds of a UKC licensed event.
- 7. Dogs are not to be left unattended when crated in soft mesh crates. No dog may be left in an unlatched or un-zippered crate.
- Except when being crated or exhibited, dogs must be kept on leash.
- 9. Exhibitors and dog owners are expected and required to clean up after their own dogs. Please potty your dog on the SOUTH side of the driveway and use the provided receptacles for disposal. Any person witnessing a violation of this rule must report it to the Event Committee. The Event Committee may ask any person violating this rule to leave the event grounds. No refund will be made if an exhibitor is asked to leave the grounds.
- 10. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs will be allowed on the grounds or in the buildings on the day of a UKC licensed event.
- 11. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- 12. UKC will vigorously support any facility that files a complaint about exhibitors who fail to keep their dogs quiet or to clean up after them. In order that the bad conduct of a few exhibitors does not spoil it for the majority of responsible exhibitors, UKC will take strong disciplinary action against any offenders.
- 13. Females in season will not be allowed to compete. A refund minus \$10 processing fee will be given with a vet's certification, if your female is withdrawn after the closing date.

ROUTE TO THE TRIAL

Take I-80 East or West to I-29 South. From I-29 South or North, take the "Lake Manawa/Iowa School for the Deaf' exit (Exit 47). Go East to the Intersection of Hwy. 92 & Hwy. 275 (Wabash Avenue). From that Intersection: Go 2 miles South on Hwy. 275 (Wabash Ave.), turn left (East) on Pioneer Trail, go 4 miles East, then turn right (South) on 240th Street. Go 1.2 miles South, cross bike trail, then it's the next place on the right (West). Look for the Basset Hound mailbox. Please be aware that there may still be road closures because of the Spring flooding. Check 511 IA or 511 NE for information before coming to the trials.

SPOT

The Socialized Pet Obedience Test (SPOT) will be offered on Saturday, June 8th, 2019. The cost of the test is \$12 per dog. Testing will take place immediately after the obedience match that day. Anna Arndt will be the evaluator. Dogs do not have to be UKC registered to take the test. Dogs of any age may take the test, however UKC recommends that dogs be at least 6 months of age. At this age dogs will have had the proper vaccinations for them to be safely around multiple dogs. If you are interested in having your dog take this test, please e-mail the trial secretary at papnose@cox.net. You will complete the application form the day of the test. You will need to bring with you a flat/buckle collar, slip collar, martingale, standard harness, head halter, Gentle Leader®, or pinch collar. No-Pull harnesses are prohibited. You will also need a 4-6 foot leash. Attached you will find a copy of the SPOT Participant Handbook which gives more information about the testing process.
