All entries received after numerical limits are reached will be placed on the alternates' list in the order received. Drawing for run order will be held at 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 14th, 2022, at the Secretary's residence. Multiple entries by a single handler will be adjusted, if possible, to provide time between runs.

EXHIBITION ONLY ENTRIES will be accepted for these trials. Competitive runs will take precedence. All entries are limited to no more than 50 per trial total. Exhibition entries must be received by the regular closing date, and the same entry fee applies to both sheep and ducks.

Make checks payable to BDOC (returned check fee is \$35). All entries must be submitted on official AKC entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entries without the AKC agreement attached are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial until corrected. (AKC Rule CH 14, Sec 4) Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted.

All owners/exhibitors should be aware that the entire motel/RV site and grounds are considered within the trial limits. You will be responsible for all damage to your motel room and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the motel/adjoining grounds will be brought to the attention of the show giving club and its Trial Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the motel/RV facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.

NOTICES TO EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 2:30 p.m. on Friday, September 23rd, 2022; and at 7:30 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday, September 24th-25th, 2022. Dogs must be removed from the trial site immediately following the conclusion of the trials each day.

These trials will be held outdoors. Please bring shade tents, chairs, crates, water for you & your dog(s), rain gear (if needed), and clean up items. A cool-off tub will be provided.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all requirements safely.

Dogs may not be left in closed vehicles without proper ventilation. If dogs are found in distress, BDOC will take appropriate action.

All dogs present must be held on leash or otherwise restricted except when working. Under NO circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena during another dog's performance. (See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the AKC herding regulations.)

Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent (unless the dog is replaced by an alternate from the alternates' list); disqualified; excused; or barred from competition by action of the Judge or Trial Committee.

If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, or other acts beyond the control of the host club, it is impossible to open or to complete a show or trial, no refund of entry fees will be made. BDOC reserves the right to cancel these trials in the event of extreme weather conditions and no entry fee refunds will be made in such case.

Exhibitors understand that they are entering this event at their own and others' risk.

Owners are responsible for errors on completed entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing, by telegram or e-mail prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Telephone, e-mail, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an Official AKC Entry Form and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules of the Official AKC Form are not acceptable.

Post-dated and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A collection fee of \$35.00 will be added to the amount of each returned check.

No refund for duplicate entries. Care will be taken to find duplicates, however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

No entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

No alcoholic beverages allowed on the trial site.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds of entry fees, if a person is asked to leave the trial site.

Absolutely no dogs under 6 months of age are permitted on the trial grounds.

Exhibitors alone are responsible for being at the trial arena gate when it is their turn to run. Judges are not required to wait for any dog.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Management is not responsible for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at the show is in the care and custody and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

Bellevue Dog Obedience Club of Nebraska, Sunshine Farm, the trial secretary, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, injury, or illness sustained by spectators, exhibitors, handlers, their employees, or children, etc., or to any of their dogs or property. Entrants and spectators to this show do so entirely at their own risk.

Bellevue Dog Obedience Club of Nebraska does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for these events.

These trials are governed by the American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read the AKC agreement on the entry form attached to the Premium List. DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

Take I-80 East or West to I-29 South. From I-29 South or North, take the "Lake Manawa/Iowa School for the Deaf" Exit 47 (right). Go East to the Intersection of Hwy. 92 & Hwy. 275 (Wabash Avenue). From that Intersection: Turn right and go 2 miles on Hwy. 275 (Wabash Ave.), turn left on Pioneer Trail (G-66), go 4 miles, then turn right on 240th Street. Go 1.2 miles, cross the bike trail, then it's the next place on the right. Look for the Basset Hound mailbox.
